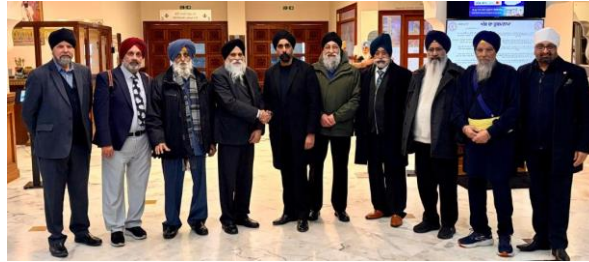


11th January 2026
