The meeting discussed issues of grooming, conversion and trial of Vickrum Singh Digwa for the murder of Henry Nowak with a Pesh Kabz.

It was agreed that SSCUK needs to be prepared to respond to the media as soon as the verdict is given. There were concerns expressed about potential misrepresentations but in any event the Council stands with the victim.

25th May 2026

Misl Day Celebrations:



The Secretary General of Supreme Sikh Council UK was invited to attend the Misl Day celebrations as the Chief Guest, an occasion organised by the Ramgarhia Council UK (RCUK) at Ramgarhia Sabha, Nottingham, in honour of the birth anniversary of Maharaja Jassa Singh Ramgarhia. The event brought together members of the community to reflect on the Maharaja's enduring legacy of leadership, courage, and service. During the programme, the Secretary General was formally recognised for his ongoing contributions to the community and was presented with a commemorative trophy by the RCUK. In a gesture of warmth and appreciation, his wife was also honoured with a beautiful bouquet of flowers. The Secretary General expressed his sincere gratitude to the RCUK committee and the sangat for their warm hospitality.

29 May 2026

Murder of Henry Nowak by Vickrum Singh Digwa and the fall out.

The Supreme Sikh Council UK provided a statement to the Telegraph which was also published in other papers such as the Birmingham Post. An interview was also given on BBC Radio.

SSCUK has condemned the murder and expressed concerns about judgements being passed about the whole community and right to wear Kirpan in a responsible way.
